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EDITORIAL

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I use the English crochet terminology in this tutorial, if you are American use the table below:

English	American
Double crochet	Single crochet
Treble	Double crochet
Double treble	Triple crochet

WHAT DO YOU NEED?

- Yarn: white, black and blue
- Crochet hook: 5.0
- Thick needle

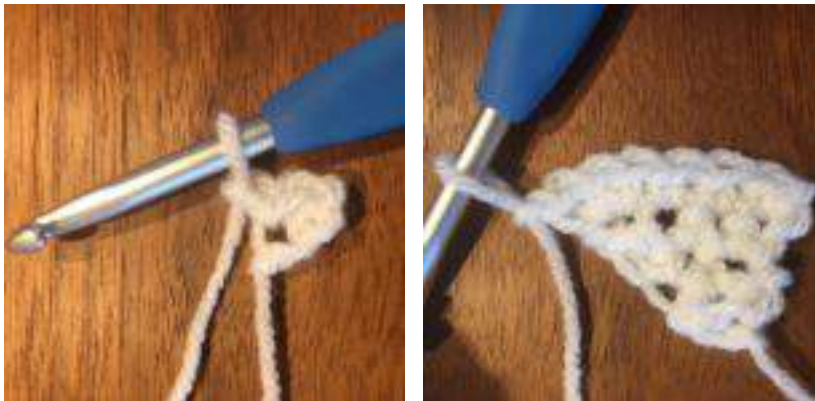
THE WHITE PART OF THE EYE

Chain 3; Form a loop by fastening it with a slipstitch in the first stitch, 1 chainstitch;

Turn your work; 1 double crochet, 2 double crochets in the last stitch (increase); 1 chainstitch;

Turn your work; Crochet a double crochet in the next two stitches and in the third two double crochets (increase); 1 chainstitch;

Turn your work; Double crochet in the next 3 stitches and 2 double crochets in the last one (increase); 1 chainstitch; Turn your work; Double crochet in the next 4 stitches and a double double crochet in the last stitch; Keep going back and forth until the eye has the desired width. You will crochet a triangle shape.



Now you need to crochet straight for a bit. Keep going but do not increase anymore on neither side. Do not forget to make the chainstitch. Keep going until you are satisfied with the length of the 'straight section'

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If the straight bit is long enough, you need to decrease to make another point. Stich a double crochet in all the stitches, but now also take out the chainstitch on both sides. This should result into decreasing on both sides to make the eye point on the other side. Crochet once all the way around with double crochets to make a neater finish.



THE BLACK IRIS

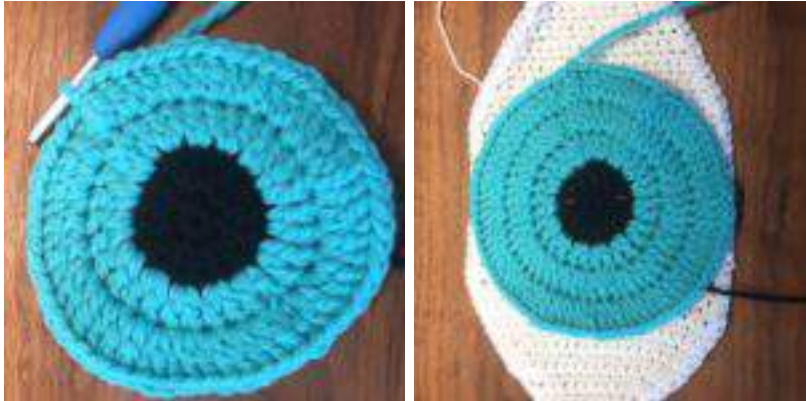
Start with black and a magic loop. Crochet 6 double crochets into the magic circle and pull to close. Close the loop with a slipstitch. * Chain 3 and crochet a treble into the same stitch. Crochet around the circle crocheting 2 trebles into each double crochet. Close this circle with a slipstitch.



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Change color to the desired iriscolor. Repeat steps from * previous round. Keep going like this until the Iris has the desired size. If it starts to wobble try to increase every other stitch.



Sew the iris onto the eye with a thick needle.

THE LASHES

Take the desired color and attach to a corner with a slipstitch. Crochet into the next 5 stitches a double crochet (base of the eyelash). * 1 chainstitch, turn your work and crochet 5 double crochets into the black ones. Turn your work (without making a slipstitch) and crochet 4 double crochets. Turn your work, again without a slipstitch and crochet 3 double crochets, turn your work, crochet 2 double crochets, turn your work, and crochet 1 double crochet. You should have a triangle now.



Slipstitch down the side of the triangle back to the eye.

Crochet 6 double crochets in the next 6 stitches. Repeat from * and go around the whole eye.

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Nearly finished! Sew with white thread and a thick needle a little 'gleam' onto the eye.



Your eye is finished!!
