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## 1 WHAT DO YOU NEED?

### 1.1 Tools

- Crochethook: 3 mm
- Thick needle
- Scissors

#### 1.2.1 Bird











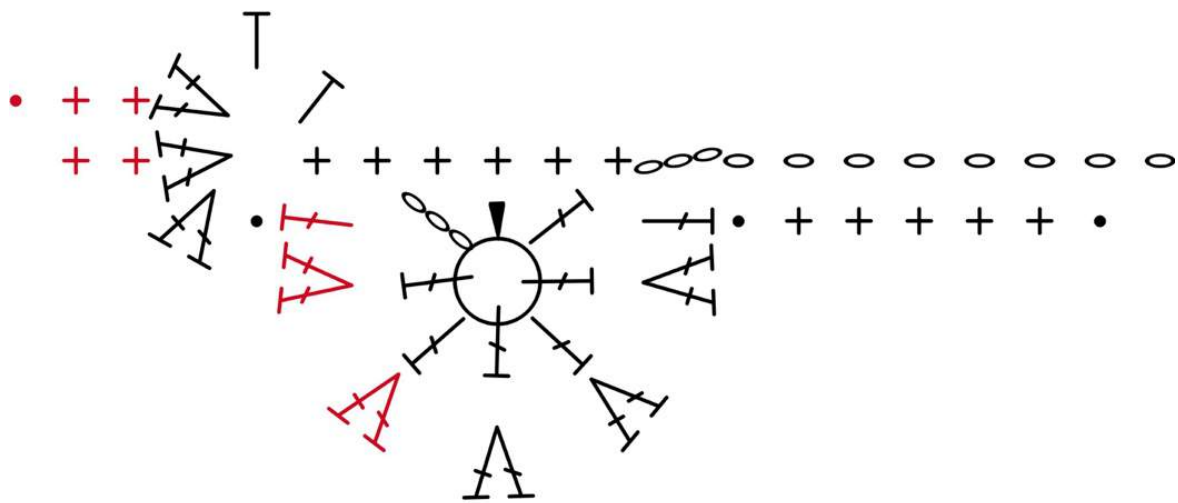
### 1.3 Symbols and crochet diagram

In the graph below you can see the terminology and symbols. I'm using US terminology – but for UK crocheters, a double crochet is a UK treble crochet!

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## 2 BIRD

Crochet hook 3.0 mm

### Round 1

With purple / blue

Start with a magic circle.

### Round 2

Chain 3, and crochet 6 dc into circle.

Pull it close. (7)

### Round 3

Chain 3, 1 dc in the same stitch. In the next 5 stitches each 2 dc. 1 dc in the last stitch.

### Round 4

The tail:

Chain 6.(6)

### Round 5

Crochet back along the chain. Begin with a sl.st., in the next 3 stitches each 1 sc.

Crochet further using sc along the back of the bird. (12)

### Round 6

Head:

Chain 3, 7 dc in the same stitch. Close with a sl.st. (9)

### Round 7

Beak:

Start with red; or any other color you wish to use, at the 3rd stitch of the neck.

Chain 4, crochet back along the chain with: 1sl.st., 1sc, 1sc. Finish with a sl.st to attach it to the head.

### Round 8

Wing

It is nice to make the wing with different kind of yarn, like fluffy or glittery yarn.

You crochet the wing separately and attach it with the needle to the body later on.

Chain 6, crochet back along this chain this way: 1sc, 1sc, 1dc, 1dc, 1sc.

Finish it off and leave a bit of yarn to sew it onto the bird.

### Round 9

Sew with black yarn an eye onto the bird's head.

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### 3 ROBBIN.

Crochet hook 3.0 mm

#### Round 1

With grey

Start with a magic circle.

#### Round 2

Chain 3, 6 dc into the circle. (7)

#### Round 3

Chain 3, dc in the same stitch. In the next 3 stitches each 2 dc. Cut off the yarn and pull through the last stitch. Go on with red. (8)

#### Round 4

With red:

In the next 2 stitches each 2 dc. And in the last stitch 1dc. (5) Finish it off by cutting the yarn and pull it through the last stitch.

#### Round 5

With brown crochet the tail.

Start at the grey side of the body. Sl.st., chain 8

#### Round 6

Crochet back along the chain like this:

Sl.st., 5sc one in each stitch, and in the last stitch a sl.st. (7)

#### Round 7

Crochet along the back of the bird using sc. (6)

#### Round 8

The head

Crochet in the same stitch: 2hdc, and 6dc. Close with a sl.st onto the head.(9)

#### Round 9

Beak with red; or any color you prefer.

Start at the 3<sup>rd</sup> stitch of the neck. Crochet 1sc and in the stitch above one more sc.

Turn and crochet 1sc. End with a sl.st.

You now have a nice pointy beak.

Leave a bit of yarn with which you can sew it onto something.

#### Round 10

Wing with beige.

Make the wing the same way as you would crochet the wing of the bird above. Sew it onto the bird with beige yarn and a thick needle.

#### Round 11

Sew an eye onto the head with black yarn and a thick needle.

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Your Robbin is finished.
